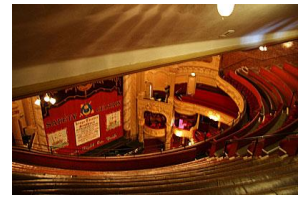




## Stories on Stage

### Learning opportunities:

#### Computer Science:
